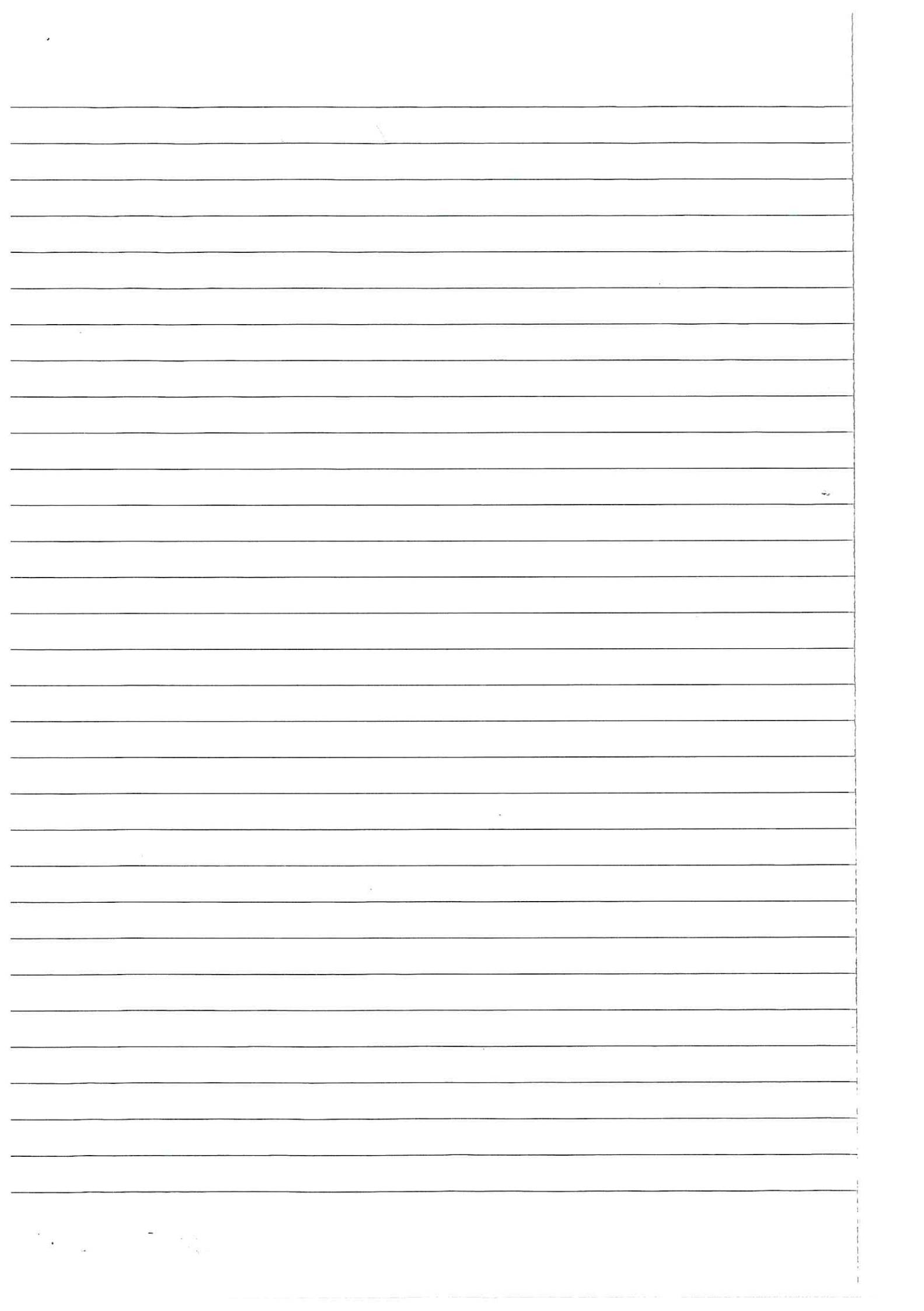
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN;

MY LIFE LONG ASSOCIATION, WITH COUNTY KILKENNY AND THE PROVINCE OF LEIKSTER, BEGAN AS A CHILD, IN THE EARLY 1940'S. AS IS THE CASE, WITH ALL THE PEOPLE OF COUNTY KILKENNY, I AM PROUD AND HONOURED, TO SHARE AND CHERISH, THIS VERY SPECIAL, BEAUTIFULL, COUNTY OF KILKENNY, ALONG WITH THIS HISTORIC PROVINCE OF LEIKSTER.

AS IS THE CASE WITH ALL COUNTIES IN IRELAND, EACH COUNTY ADJOINS NEIGHBOURING COUNTIES, AS IS GEOGRAPHICALLY NECESSARY. IN THE CASE OF COUNTY KILKENNY; IT ADJOINS COUNTIES OF, LAOIS, CARLOW, WEXFORD, TIPPERARY, WATERFORD.

THE MAJORITY OF ALL THE COUNTIES IN IRELAND, CO-EXIST WITH THEIR NEIGHBOURING COUNTIES, IN A CORDIAL, PEACEFULL SPIRIT OF GOODWILL AND RESPECT FOR THEIR NEIGHBOURING COUNTIES; TRADITION, UNIQUE HISTORY AND BOUNDARIES. THIS RESPECT FOR EACH OTHER'S TERRITORY, ENABLES CO-OPERATION TO DEVELOPE.

THE ATTEMPT BY WATERFORD, TO TAKE CONTROL AND POSSESION OF PART OF A PORTION OF SOUTH KILKENNY, BY THEIR GUISE OF A BACK DOOR, BOUNDARY REVIEW, IS A BLATANT ATTEMPT -

BY WATERFORD TO AN EX PART OF COUNTY KILKENNY AND THE PROVINCE OF LEINSTER. THIS ACTION BY WATERFORD, IS TOTALLY UNACCEPTABLE, BY ALL THE PEOPLE OF KILKENNY, WHO DEMOCRATICALLY, DO NOT WISH, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE, FOR WATERFORD, OR ANY OTHER NEIGHBOURING COUNTY, TO TAKE CONTROL OR POSSESSION OF THEIR SOVEREIGN LAND OR TERRITORY. THIS THREAT BY WATERFORD IS SIMILAR TO THE PRACTICE, OF LAND GRABBING, THAT EXISTED IN IRELAND, IN THE DARK DISTANT PAST.

ALSO, IN ESSENCE, THIS THREAT BY WATERFORD, IS A THREAT BY THE PROVINCE OF MUNSTER, TO GRAB PART OF THE PROVINCE OF LEINSTER.

IN A SOMEWHAT SIMILAR MATTER, THIS THREAT BY WATERFORD TO TAKE POSSESSION OF PART OF KILKENNY, AGAINST THE WISHES OF ALL THE PEOPLE OF KILKENNY, IS IN THE SAME VEIN, AS WHAT IRELAND ENDURED, FOR APPROXIMATELY, ONE THOUSAND YEARS, BY THE OCCUPATION, OF ITS SOVEREIGN DEMOCRATIC TERRITORY BY A NEIGHBOURING COUNTRY. IT TOOK BY THE MOST HISTORICAL EVENT IN IRELAND'S PAST, THE BRAVERY OF THOSE HEROIC MEN AND WOMEN, WHO SACRIFICED THEIR LIVES, FOR IRELAND'S FREEDOM, IN THE 1916 RISING, TO FIGHT FOR IRELAND ITS' CHERISHED FREEDOM.

IN THE SAME CONTEXT, THE PEOPLE OF COUNTY KILKENNY, HAVE A DEMOCRATIC RIGHT, TO PRESERVE ALL OF THEIR PRECIOUS COUNTY, AGAINST THE THREAT OF OCCUPATION, OF PART OF ITS TERRITORY, BY A NEIGHBOURING COUNTRY; IN WHATEVER CAMOUFLAGED MANNER, IT IS BEING PURSUED.

THE HISTORIC, CLEARLY DEFINED BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN COUNTY KILKENNY AND COUNTY WATERFORD, IS THE CENTRE LINE OF THE RIVER SUIR, ON ITS UNINTERRUPTED ROUTE, FROM CARRICK ON SUIR IN COUNTY TIPPERARY, RUNNING BETWEEN KILKENNY AND WATERFORD, TO WHERE IT JOINS THE RIVER BARROW, AFTER SHOWHILL, IN COUNTY KILKENNY, TO THE CENTRE LINE OF THE RIVER BARROW; THIS CENTRE LINE OF THE RIVER BARROW IS ALSO, THE BOUNDARY LINE, BETWEEN COUNTIES KILKENNY AND WEXFORD, ON ITS ROUTE INLAND.
