Dear Members Boundary Committee;

I would like to express my strong opposition to any territory grab in South Kilkenny by Waterford Council.

Kilkenny is a relatively small County and cannot afford to cede any land or assets or people to a neighbouring County. We in Kilkenny support Kilkenny, Waterford, Carlow and Wexford forming a development area "South East".
